Chef Susan M. Creighton's years at DC's Morrison-Clark Inn established her, a Midwesterner by birth, as one of the city's leading interpreters of Southern cooking, particularly the vegetable cooking of the Chesapeake Bay region. Her reopening of the Majestic Cafe, a landmark in Old Town Alexandria since the 1940s, was eagerly anticipated, and her fans have not been disappointed. Lindeborg's cooking feels right at home in this space. Her first criterion for putting a dish on her menu seems to be that it tastes good. There's no pretense, no affectation, just good flavor.

Just a few months old, 2941 Restaurant already is one of the top dining destinations in Virginia. The name is the restaurant's address on Fairview Park Drive in Falls Church. Both the kitchen and dining area are noteworthy. The kitchen is under the control of a young pro, Chef Jonathan Krinn, and an experienced pro, general manager Pascal Dionot, a longtime instructor at L'Academie de Cuisine. Dionot has paid Krinn a big compliment--of his many hundreds of students, Dionot decided to enter a restaurant venture with Krinn. Between his student days at L'Academie and the opening of 2941, Krinn sharpened his skills at the Gramercy Tavern in New York City.
